DOWNLOAD YOUR TICKETS

Print or pre-download your tickets prior to arriving at the venue to avoid delays at entry.

If your ticket is on your phone, screenshot it before arriving at the gates.

Turn up the brightness on your phone to maximum setting for fast scanning. If your screen is damaged, please print your ticket.

STAY HYDRATED

Bring an empty plastic bottle to fill with water at the multiple free water stations. These will be around the bars. There are also bottled water and soft drinks available for purchase at the bars as well.

TAKE REGULAR BREAKS

Find a space to enjoy some chill out time and rest throughout the duration of the festival.

FUEL YOUR BODY

Keep your energy levels up by enjoying some of the delicious food options available from our vendors.

PREPARE FOR ALL WEATHER CONDITIONS

The weather is always tough to predict. QEll Park is an uncovered venue, so we recommend preparing for all conditions on the day.

That means suitable clothing like a raincoat or poncho for the rain, plus hats and sunscreen to protect from the sun.

TAKE CARE

Take care before, during and after Juicy Fest.

Be safe, be responsible and look out for those around you.

BE KIND

Bring good energy to Juicy Fest.

Be respectful of other festival-goers and be kind to one another.

SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING

At the end of the event, FREE BUSES will be available to transport attendees to one of the following destinations:

- **Christchurch CBD — Manchester St Super Stop (cnr of Manchester St and Worcester St).**
- **Kaiapoi Police Station Stop (Williams St) onto Rangiora Train Station.**
- **Riccarton Westfield Stop (Riccarton Rd).**

Buses will depart from the bus stops outside of the Recreation Centre adjacent to the venue - follow the signs.

ROAD CLOSURES & TRAVEL TIPS

Access to the venue for drop-offs & parking is via Travis Rd or Bower Ave.

PARKING

Limited parking is available in the field beside the venue. If this is full on arrival, be prepared to make alternative arrangements.

Limited parking may be available on streets surrounding QEII Park.

MOBILITY PARKING

There is dedicated mobility parking, which can be booked by contacting event@juicyfest.co.nz.

This parking is strictly for mobility parking permit holders and a valid permit must be displayed on the vehicle window on arrival at the venue.

These are available on a strict first-come, first-served basis.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

EXPECTATIONS OF ATTENDEES

Aged 18+ and have valid ID (Passport, NZ Driver Licence, Kiwi Access Card only).

Hold a legitimate ticket purchased from an authorised seller.

Not currently tresspassed from the venue.

Allow authorised staff to search possessions for prohibited items.

Wear footwear at all times.

Do not display gang insignia.

Anyone who refuses the searches, appears intoxicated, is under the influence of drugs, exhibits disorderly behaviour, or holds illegitimate tickets may be denied entry, asked to leave the venue and/or be tresspassed.

****Prohibited items will be confiscated and will not be returned. Conditions are subject to change without notice.**

EXPECTATIONS OF ATTENDEES

Do not behave in an unacceptable or disruptive manner.

Do not take part in dangerous activities such as aggressive moshing, crowd surfing and climbing.

Understand bringing personal items into the festival is at owner's risk.

Understand pass outs are not issued for the festival.

No leaving or attempting to leave festival grounds with alcohol.

Do not smoke cigarettes, e-cigarettes or vapes.

Do not take part in unsolicited selling of merch, ads, promotional giveaways, or unauthorised soliciting or customer surveys.

Comply with directions from event staff, security & the NZ Police.

***Failure to meet expectations could result in the removal from the event, arrest, fines or prosecution.**

SECURITY & SEARCHES ON ENTRY

Festival Management and its representatives reserve the right to request patrons to present any clothing, bags and other carried items for searching, including being subject to a pat down security search and/or a scanner search before entering the stadium.

If you refuse to present any of the requested items for searching, you will be denied entry.

ALCOHOL BAN

Christchurch City Council has approved a temporary alcohol ban at QEII Park during large scale events (4000+ attendees).

Event organisers can still apply for special licences to serve alcohol at these events but the aim is to limit anti-social behaviour in non-licensed areas and the surrounding area on event days. We are in full support of this.

The ban will cover the area bounded by: Ascot Ave, Bower Ave, Travis Rd, Frost Rd, Beach Rd, and back to Ascot Ave, including both sides of the named roads.

DRUG & ALCOHOL POLICY

- **Juicy Festival complies with the Liquor Licensing Authority and prohibits the serving of alcohol to intoxicated or under-aged persons.**
- **There will be zero tolerance for intoxication.**
- **Those who arrive at the gates intoxicated will be refused entry into the event, and patrons who become intoxicated will be escorted from the venue.**
- **Intoxicated persons who are apprehended with alcohol will be escorted from the premises.**
- **Juicy Festival maintains a strict 'no drugs' policy.**
- **Illicit drugs are prohibited and will be confiscated at the gate.**
- **Any persons apprehended with drugs in their possession will be escorted from the premises.**
- **Incidents involving alcohol or drugs will be referred to the NZ Police where the situation required.**
