
# Christchurch City Council has approved a temporary alcohol ban at QEII Park during large scale events (4000+ attendees).

Event organisers can still apply for special licences to serve alcohol at these events but the aim is to limit anti-social behaviour

# in non-licensed areas and the surrounding area on event days. We are in full support of this.

The ban will cover the area bounded by: Ascot Ave, Bower Ave, Travis Rd, Frost Rd, Beach Rd, and back to Ascot Ave, including both sides of the named roads.
