



# ROAD GLOSURES & TRAVELTIPS There is no access to Mereury Baypark Truman Lane will be closed at the Te Maunga Interchange (SH29A) from 9am Sunday, 7 January to Iam Monday, 8 January.

# Only festival buses, Truman Lane businesses, and residents visiting the Te Maunga transfer station, will be able to access Truman Lane via Mangatawa Link Road/Sandhurst Rd.

# The road will be reduced to one lane with stop-go management providing access to festival buses and residents as required. There will be a lot of people walking between Arataki and Mercury Baypark, with extensive traffic management in place to ensure their safety.

# Motorists should avoid travelling at peak festival start and finish times or take an alternative route if possible. If you need to travel through these areas, please drive carefully and expect delays.

# <u>There is no drop-off/pick-up zone at Mercury Baypark. A public drop-off zone is available at the on Truman Lane via Mangatawa</u>






